

On November 15, 2016 the Virginia State Corporation Commission Hearing Examiner issued his final report and recommendation for the route of Dominion Powers proposed 230kV double circuit transmission line that would serve a new local substation west of Haymarket. The hearing examiner chose the Carver Road alternative, one of five alternatives. The case has now been passed on to the three Corporation Commissioners for their review and final order. Other alternatives along Route 66 are much less intrusive to the Gainesville/Haymarket area and there is still a chance that local officials and organized opponents to the Hearing Examiner's recommendation will prevail in having the Commission select one of these routes. The public meeting being held by Supervisor Jeanine Lawson on January 9th is an important part of this process.

For your information the Carver Road Alternative is shown on the above map. The Carver Road Alternative crosses I-66 at the Rt 29 interchange then travels a short distance along John Marshal Highway (Rt 55). It then goes west along a path north of the Somerset Shopping Center, and then proceeds along an undeveloped portion of land between the Hopewell Landing residential community and the Somerset residential community. It then crosses Old Carolina Road and turns NW to intersect route 15. At no time is this alternative visible to residential units in Lake Manassas nor does it run along Route 29.
